Call to Action

Collect mature toads

Toad Collecting sessions every third Thursday at 7.00pm (6.30pm for new helpers) - Meet in the resident BBQ Area (rear of the County Club) for induction

Collect toads anytime – the fridge freezer is now in place to cool down and freeze your catch, no more than 10 toads in each bag

***** REMEMBER – toads are toxic, so use gloves *****

Become a Watercourse Coordinator and make a Toadpole Trap.

As a community, lets eradicate these invasive pests.

They are killing our native species of frogs, birds, lizards, and fish.

- We need helpers on TOAD collection nights (normally THIRD THURSDAY of the month) - **It's a great walk & good comradery with your neighbours.**

- You can collect anytime by yourself.
- We need residents backing on a watercourse to be a TOAD POLE spotter or catcher.
- We can show you the difference between frogs and toads, tadpoles and toad poles so you can do it anytime.
- We provide a freezer for you to store TOADS or TOADPOLES you collect (at the bar-b-que area at the club).
- We need residents and golfers to spot where TOAD POLE swarms are located.
- Finding and catching TOADPOLES is the most efficient way of eradication – you can eliminate hundreds at a time with a scoop

In one year, volunteers in the Pacific Harbour Golf Club Community have delivered over 2000 toads to the University of Queensland for research purposes and eliminated over 20,000 toad poles.
